	The airport car rental industry has evolved from the 1950's style of an in-airport counter with rental cars close-by into mainly an off-airport remote operation either through their own facility or a combined off-airport car rental facility – commonly called a CONRAC. Technologies such as the internet and apps have made it easy for individuals to offer their own vehicle for rent, similar to the airbnb practice where people offer their homes or condos for rent to others. The most recognizable company currently providing services within this growing carsharing industry is Turo. Turo representatives and airport representatives will provide an update for attendees — the current status of this industry and some of the typical arrangements that have been made for their operation at both small and large airports.
